BM-21

If you want to see what it's like to drive naked on the battlefield, try the BM-21. Actually, this missile launcher gives the driver surprising protection from small arms fire. However, without a machine gunner, there is no way to defend against enemy rocket launchers or tanks. Your best strategy is to stay out of sight, but within range of an enemy Control Point. Keep the missiles flying to pound an enemy garrison into submission. When the area is clear, roll up to the flag, capture the base, and find your next hiding place.



Patton

Forget everything you learned about freewheeling a Sheridan over jungle paths. The Patton is a different animal, and the Quang Tri-1972 map is anything but freewheeling. You'll need a two-person crew to man the Patton, and the machine gunner is

critical because of enemy RPG carriers popping up behind every rubble pile. When manning the big gun, use the Patton for infantry support, lobbing shells over your ground troops to clear the way. Although you are capable of winning a close-quarters battle with an N.V.A. T-54, you want to avoid being trapped on the crowded streets of Quang Tri. If you are stationary for more than a few seconds, you're likely to go up in flames.



T-54

Like the Patton, the T-54 requires two crewmembers, but the N.V.A. tank is more maneuverable than the Patton. Try using two T-54s in tandem, with the machine gunner in one vehicle clearing out infantry, while the main gunner in the second tank takes out hard targets.
